



**Volunteers for VBS in Poland!** If anyone is interested in Vacation Bible School in Poland, I would encourage you to contact Mrs. Karen Ruhlig. She is a past CID LWML President and current member of CID Evangelism Commission. There are 40 churches in Poland who would like to have a Vacation Bible School. There is at least one group from Trinity Lutheran Church in Bloomington that goes every July. Before Communism, Poland boasted huge cathedrals in which thousands worshipped. Currently these huge cathedrals have only 100 or less worshipping in each. Most of the children attending the VBS out of Bloomington have no church membership. All need to hear the Gospel. Concordia Publishing House VBS materials are used. I am planning to take a second group to a second church. We will be gone 12 days in mid-July with a cost of about \$2,400 to each volunteer. This group has been approved by our District Office. Airline tickets need to be purchased early so I will need to know immediately if volunteers can go this year.
