

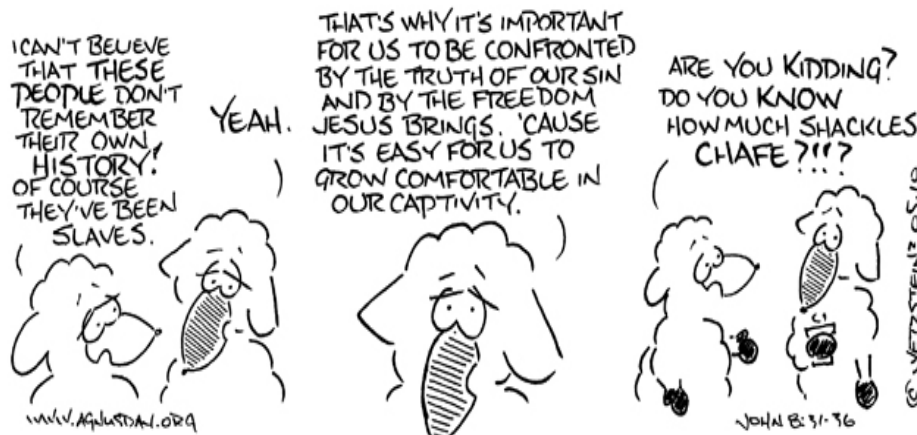

Operation Christmas Child!
