

Vial of Life - The Vial of Life, sponsored by the Community Parish Nurse Program, is designed to help emergency personnel provide the best possible care and quickest response time. Senior citizens, people who live alone and anyone with a chronic illness can benefit from the Vial of Life. This includes anyone with diabetes, epilepsy, kidney disease, heart disease or any other illness where emergency care may be necessary. This Vial is a container that holds important medical information such as a list of medicines, allergies, and special needs. It may also contain a copy of a living will and contact names and phone numbers. It is kept in the refrigerator in a specific location where responders can easily find it. One may also be kept in the automobile glove compartment. When the vials arrive, I will put in the back of the church by bulletin board.
