

American Heart Month: February is American Heart Month. The first heart month took place in February 1964. While American Heart Month is a federally designated month in the USA, it's important to realize that cardiovascular disease knows no borders. Cardiovascular disease, including heart disease and stroke, remains the leading global cause of death with more than 17.3 million deaths each year. That number is expected to rise to more than 23.6 million by 2030.

Know your numbers? They could just save your life. Talk with your healthcare provider today to learn about your *blood pressure, cholesterol, blood sugar, and BMI (body mass index)*. Your heart depends on it.

Heart attacks are a disease of the vessels. The vessel walls get narrowed and inflamed from high blood pressure and cholesterol fat. Plaques develop and can break off and prevent blood flow and oxygen to the heart.

What are the signs of a heart attack?

- Chest heaviness, burning, pressure, tightness or squeezing
- Discomfort in the jaw, shoulder, back, or down the arm
- Shortness of breath, dizziness, or weakness is seen more in women
- Nausea, indigestion, or fatigue
- Call 911 with these symptoms. Let the professionals decide if it is a heart attack.

There are 2 types of strokes. 87% of strokes are caused by a blood clot in the vessels of the brain. 13% are caused by a vessel bleeding in the brain.

What are the signs of a stroke? Remember FAST

- **F.** Face droops or is numb
- A. Arm weakness or if held in front of you drifts downward
- **S.** Speech difficulty
- **T.** Time to call 911. Note the time symptoms started. Clot busting medications need to be started right away.
