

Prevent Skin Cancer

Follow these tips to protect your skin from the sun's damaging ultraviolet rays and reduce your risk of skin cancer.

- Seek shade when appropriate, remembering that the sun's rays are strongest between 10am and 2pm.
- Wear protective clothing such as lightweight long-sleeved shirt, pants, and a wide-brimmed hat and sunglasses when possible.
- Generously apply a broad-spectrum, water-resistant sunscreen with an SPF of 30 or higher. Broad-spectrum sunscreen provides protection from both UVA and UVB rays. Use sunscreen even on cloudy days. Apply enough sunscreen to cover all exposed skin.
- Apply sunscreen every 2 hours or after swimming or sweating.
- Use extra caution near water, snow and sand as they will reflect the rays of the sun and increase your chance of sunburn.
- Avoid tanning beds. Ultraviolet light can cause skin cancer and premature skin aging.
- Consider using a self-tanning product. Continue to use sunscreen with it.
- Perform regular skin self-exams to detest skin cancer early, when it's most treatable and see a board-certified dermatologist if you notice new or suspicious spots on your skin, or anything changing, itching, or bleeding.

The ABCDE's of skin exams for melanoma:

- A. **Asymmetry.** One half is unlike the other half.
- B. **Border.** An irregular, scalloped or poorly defined border.
- **C. Color.** Is varied from one area to another; has shade of tan, brown, or black, or is sometimes white, red, or blue.
- **D. Diameter.** Melanomas are usually greater than 6mm(the size of a pencil eraser) when diagnosed, but can be smaller.
- **E. Evolving.** A mole or skin lesion that looks different from the rest or is changing in size, shape or color.
