

Service Notes: During this "green season" - the post-Pentecost season, we are reminded to focus on our life in Christ as the Holy Spirit blesses us with His power. The readings today show us that we are curved in on self, or only out for what we feel we can get for ourselves. In the Old Testament Lesson, Jeremiah is speaking strongly against the people of God because of their unfaithfulness. The people react by showing a desire to kill him, reminding us of the risks we take when proclaiming God's word into a sinful world. James, in the Epistle, encourages us to submit to God by abandoning selfish ambition. Today's Gospel begins with Jesus' second prediction of his suffering and death, followed immediately by His disciples arguing about who would be greatest, showing that even as the disciples are talking directly to Jesus, they are inclined to think inwardly. Paraments remain green, the color of life in nature, reminding us of our lives of service for our God.
