



#### Announcements - 1

Service Notes: Today, we celebrate Reformation with a special service modeled after Luther's Deutsche Messe, or German Communion Service, first published in 1526, where Luther wrote hymns for the basic Ordinaries (Kyrie, Gloria, Creed, Sanctus) of the Communion service. The service has been adapted based on the "sing-ability" of the various hymns. The first hymn, the "Kyrie hymn" was re-written by Pastor McPike and set to the "Lord's Prayer Hymn" tune of Dr. Luther, "Vater Unser". The Creed hymn will be sung as a solo between the articles of the creed. The Sanctus hymn is mostly solo, with the congregation invited to sing the song of the angels. The sermon portion of the service is a skit that will be acted out between Pastor McPike (Luther) and his brother Randy (Fr. Staupitz) with Randy's daughter Cassie as narrator. After the choir interlude based on the Luther hymn "Ein' Feste Burg ist unser Gott", pastor will summarize the key points in a homily. Paraments are red, the color of blood and fire. Red represents the zeal with which the reformers did their work (fire) and that they were willing to "give their all" (blood) for their part in what has now become known as the Lutheran Reformation.
