



Announcements

Service Notes: The feast of the Epiphany, celebrated last Sunday, has also an entire season. That season begins and ends with two Sundays with similar theme from different perspectives. Today is the First Sunday after the Epiphany: The Baptism of our Lord, where Jesus, our Lord begins His formal ministry. In Jesus' baptism, all three persons of the Trinity are simultaneously present: God the Father is the voice from Heaven, Jesus of course is God the Son, and the Holy Spirit descends like a dove. The Father's voice makes use of two texts from the Old Testament to declare the ministry of Christ: "This is my beloved son" - a quote of Psalm 2, the Psalm used for coronation of Kings in Israel; and "with whom I am well pleased", a quote of Isaiah 42:1, part of the servant songs of Isaiah. Simply put, this declares that Jesus is our King who has come to serve. Paraments are white, the color of holiness. Baptism is holy because our holy God in Jesus Christ took all our sins and gives us credit for His holiness.
