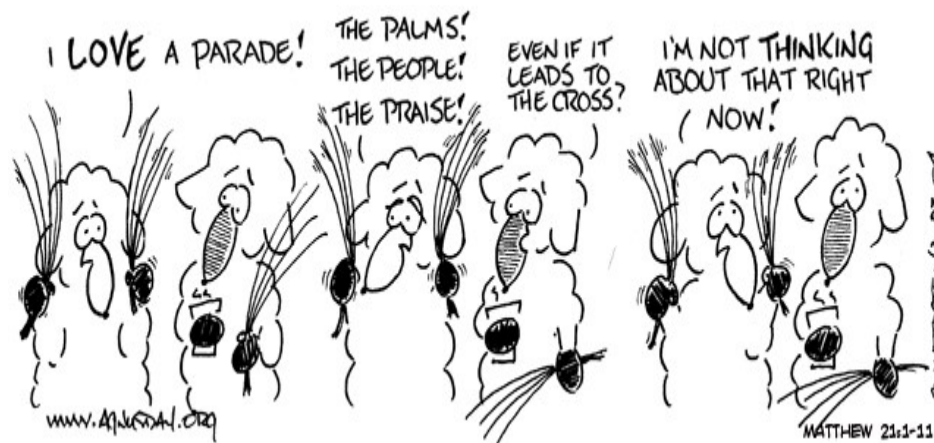

Self Care for the Stressed

Love Thy neighbor as thyself. Then God help your neighbor J

Stress is not the event...it is our perception of the event. The perception

- of a threat to my well-being.
- that I'm unable to cope.

So much stress is related to worry about future and past regrets: the inability to stay in the present. Are you living your life according to your values? What is the distance between what I say I believe in and what I actually do? Self care is essential to have the energy to help others. Self -care is not "Self"ish, waste of time, or trivial. Why do we embrace full speed living? Which person are you? "Good morning God" or "Good God, morning" Do I give *of* myself or give *up* myself?

Care of the caregiver. Be gentle with yourself. Remind yourself that you are a (fill in the blank), not a magician: we cannot change anyone else-we can only change how we relate to them. How do you care for self: relationships, pets, diet, exercise, vices, health, annual physicals?
