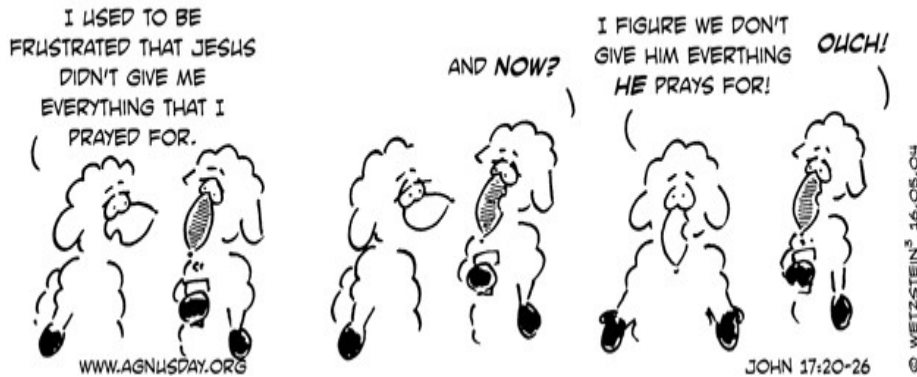

Welcome in Jesus' Name

Lutherans believe that Jesus Christ is present in the Sacrament so that we receive His true body and blood along with the bread and wine (Mark 14:22, 24; 1 Corinthians 10:16). We further believe that in this Sacrament, we receive the forgiveness of sins (Matthew 26:28) and strength to live an improved Christian life (Galatians 2:20). A worthy communicant is one who is truly repentant of his/her sins and who resolves to amend his/her life (1 Corinthians 11:28). Furthermore, this Sacrament is not only a communion with Christ (Matthew 18:20; 1 Corinthians 10:16), but also with one another (1 Corinthians 10:17; Acts 2:42). Those desiring to commune with us for the first time should register with the pastor in his office BEFORE the service begins.

On Sunday June 9th at 4:00pm the renovated and enlarged pipe organ at St. John Lutheran Church in Champaign will be rededicated and celebrated with an organ concert by Keith Williams. All are welcome to attend this celebration, which will include music by Praetorius, Buxtehude, Bach, Durufle and others. The organ has been rebuilt and enlarged by Buzard Pipe Organ Builders of Champaign over the past 7 years, with the recent work adding several new stops to the instrument. Keith Williams is both the Organist/Choir Director at St. John Lutheran Church and the Service Director at Buzard Pipe Organ Builders. St. John Lutheran Church is located at the corner of Mattis Ave. and John Street, and is fully handicapped accessible.
