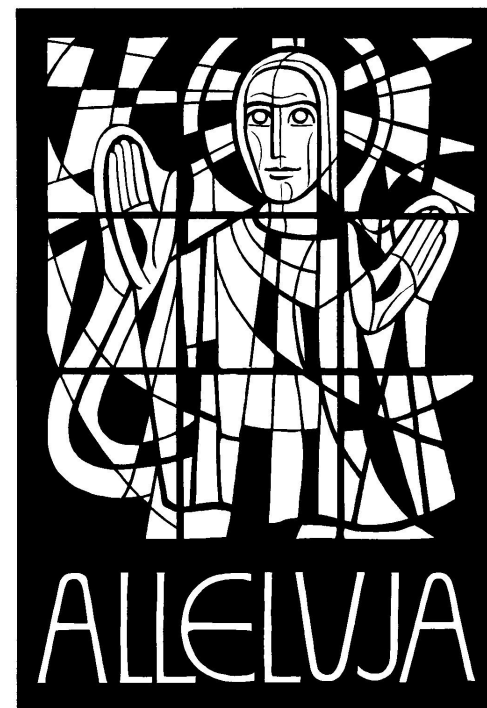

Early Easter Narrative

The altar, stripped on Maundy Thursday and bare for Good Friday, has the white paraments covered with black, reminding us that while Jesus was alive early on Easter Morning, His followers learned of the information a bit more slowly. During the solo, the black will be removed to reveal the white, and the remaining dressing will be applied for the rest of our joyous celebration of Christ's resurrection from the dead.

Christ Lag in Todesbanden while veil is removed from altar

P: Christ is Risen!

C: He is Risen Indeed! Alleluia!
