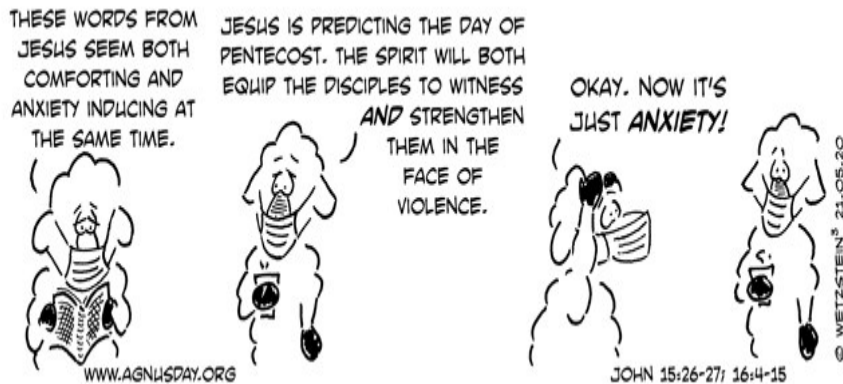

Altar Flowers: The flowers on the Altar today are given to the glory of God for Pentecost Sunday by the Altar Guild.

Pentecost is the celebration of the Holy Spirit. The festival falls 50 days after Easter. Pentecost is the third most important festival of the Church, following Easter and Christmas. Pentecost is a celebration of the coming of the Holy Spirit in the form of what seemed to be tongues of fire that came to rest on each of Jesus' disciples. The Holy Spirit enabled the disciples to speak languages other than their own. Thus they were equipped to go out into the world to tell all nations and people about Jesus.
