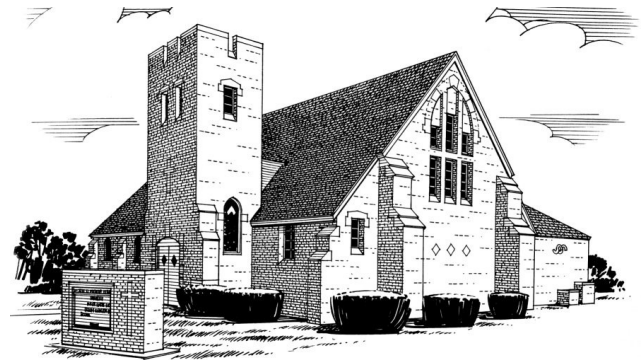

Additional Announcements

COVID-19 CONSIDERATIONS: On June 11, 2021, the state of Illinois moved to “Phase 5” of reopening. A major feature of Phase 5 is masks are no longer required for fully vaccinated individuals. While this may look in most situations like things have “returned to normal”, it is only a movement to a “greater normal”. After discussing the implications of this for our church, the Church council is suggesting the following considerations going forward:

1. Masks
 - A. Required for those not vaccinated
 - B. Optional for those fully vaccinated. Appreciated for all; helps with continuing infection control.
2. Worship service:
 - A. Offering will still be collected in the back.
 - B. Please use the communion cards to register your communion attendance.
 - C. Communion will still be served in the back of the church and at the end of the sidewalk for those in cars.
 - D. Radio Osman will broadcast the service for those choosing to remain in their cars for the service.
 - E. Communion will be given to the people in the parking lot first, then to those in the building. Those worshipping in the church will be dismissed as we have been doing...back pews first.
 - F. Calling ahead to register for worship attendance is no longer necessary.
 - G. Worshippers are reminded that while communion continues to be distributed, please be considerate and remain quiet.
