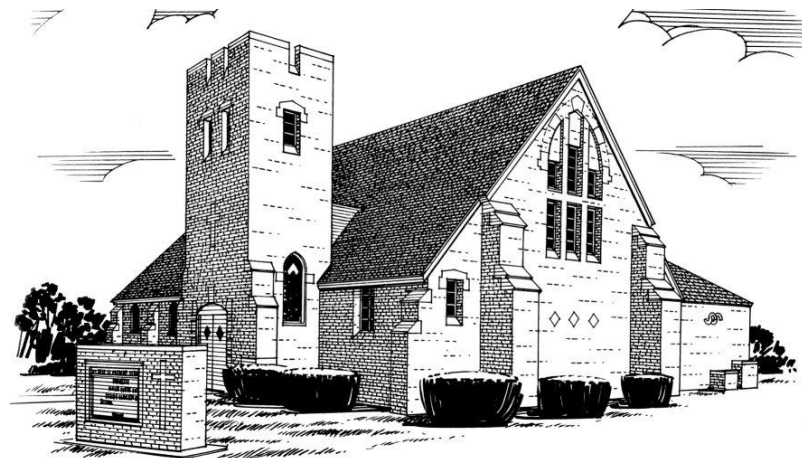

The Church Council Meeting will be held THIS Wednesday, July 20th, at 6:30 PM. The quarterly congregational meeting will be held on Sunday, July 24th, after the regular worship service.

The 60th Convention of the Central Illinois District of the Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod will be held at the Crowne Plaza Hotel in Springfield, Illinois starting this evening. Election of Central Illinois officers and many other business items will be discussed during these days. Brenda Hendricks will be the voting delegate for our congregation.

Lutheran High School in Springfield is dealing with a major structural problem due to previous underground coal mining. The engineers who were called in to inspect the building recommended that the building at 3000 West Washington Street not be occupied at this time. Mine subsidence is "a sinking of the ground due to the failure of the underground structures remaining from historical coal mining in the area". The administration and the school board are seeking alternative location opportunities for the upcoming school year. As of last fall, the school listed an enrollment of nearly 150 students. Please keep this Lutheran high school in your prayers.
