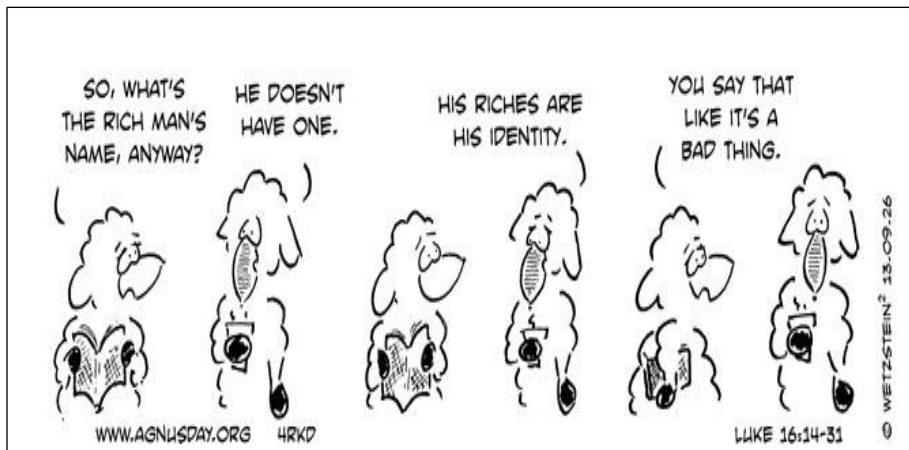

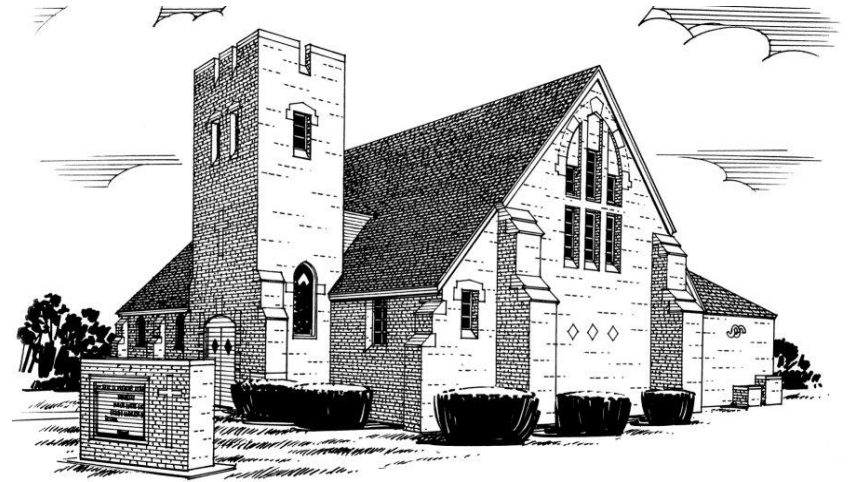

Recycling! The Central Illinois District LWML ladies collect several items that are recycled. They collect used devotion booklets such as Portals of Prayer which are given to prison ministries. They collect used stamps that you can trim from your mail with a ¼ inch border. These are given to a stamp collector in Southern Illinois and he, in turn, pays for the ones that he buys. They collect used orange pill bottles (prescription labels removed) that are recycled into park benches. They collect used Bibles that are given to Love Packages, an organization in Butler, Illinois which sends Christian material to people around the world. If you have any of these items, please add them to the box on the back pew of the church. They will be delivered to Camp Cilca on October 7th where appropriate people will take them to their recycling centers.
