

Background on today's sermon: Rev David Andrus was born in 1958 in Wausau, Wisconsin. At the age of 8, he contracted a rare eye disease called Coats' disease. Treatments were attempted, but by age 11, treatments failed, and Andrus was left completely blind. With the help of his family, he finished school, then attending Concordia College, St. Paul where he met and married his wife just before their last year. David graduated in the pre-seminary program, and his wife, Debb, graduated as a Director of Christian Education. They then moved to St. Louis, where he attended Concordia Seminary, where he graduated from in 1985. He has served as pastor of Our Redeemer Lutheran Church in Overland, Missouri and also as director of the Lutheran Mission of Blind and Visually Impaired Persons. In August 2014, he started serving St. Paul Lutheran Church, a congregation in the St. Louis inner city.
