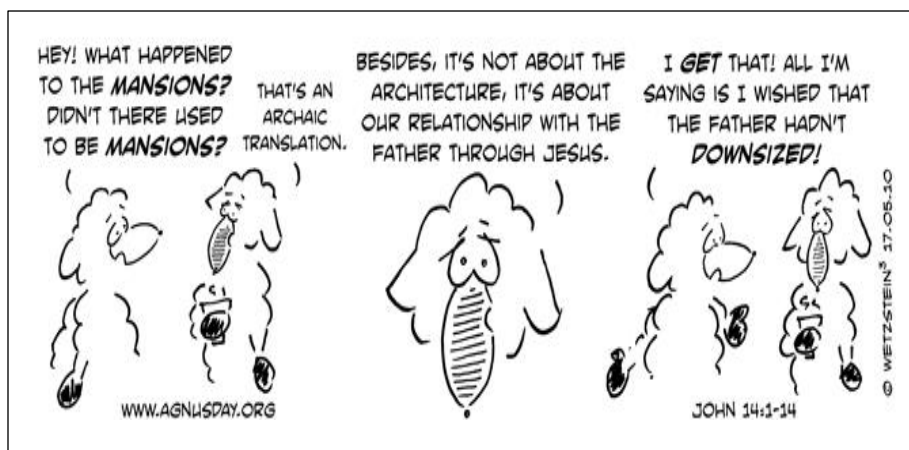

Ladies Aid/LWML ladies will meet THIS Thursday, May 11th, at 7 PM. Take notice of the time as this is our first evening meeting of the year. Debbie Martin will have the topic and the hostesses will be Brenda Edwards and Marsha Warsaw. The roll call will be answered by a favorite Bible verse on praise. All ladies of the congregation are invited to attend.

Last October on LWML Sunday there were mite boxes on the back table which members were encouraged to take home and fill with extra change. We thank the members for their contributions. These mites helped pay the 2022-2023 mission grants of our Central Illinois District LWML. The mites from all the Central Illinois LWML groups and other contributions totaled \$108,013.72. 75% of the money collected was used for student aid for church workers at our seminaries, shipping of a full container overseas for Orphan Grain Train, supplies for Orphan Grain Train, classroom experiences for CID Lutheran schools, supplies for family life center in Effingham, communication and transportation for Sterling Lutheran Church in Alaska, support for Missionary Hayden Rensner in Czech Republic, and textbooks for Ghana Concordia Preparatory School. 25% of the mite collection is used for the National LWML mission grants. There are mite boxes on the back pew if you would like to support the 2023-2024 mission grants that were voted on last week at the convention. Filled mite boxes can be returned to the back pew at any time.
