

Secretary Report:

Reading of minutes from February 2, 2010 Council Meeting. Motion to accept by Dwight Hooker. Second by Darwin Warsaw. All in favor: 7. Motion passed.

Treasure Report:

January 31, 2010 balance = \$25,541.04

February 28, 2010 balance = \$29,360.76

Motion to accept by Darwin Warsaw. Second by Larry Lutz. All in favor: 7. Motion passed.

Mike noted we had \$150.00 in discretionary funds and asked what the council wanted to do with it. (1) Motion by Don Warsaw to donate \$150.00 to LCMS World Relief and Human Care for Chili in March 2010. All in favor: 7. Motion passed.

Treasurer Hendricks also mentioned costs for the Easter egg hunt (\$60.00) and Confirmation (\$55.00 per person) may have to be covered from different funds than in previous years.
