Immanuel Lutheran Church Voters Meeting Minutes January 13th, 2013

The January voter meeting was called to order by Chairman Rick Hardesty with Pastor McPike opening the meeting with prayer. No new members signed the Constitution and 36 members were present.

Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Mike Hendricks gave the Treasurer's report with a quarterly balance of \$96,535.02 as of

December 31st, 2012. A motion to approve the Treasurer's report was made by Darwin Warsaw. 2nd by Don Warsaw. Motion carried.

Next on order, Chairman Hardesty called for the annual vote of new council positions. Chairman Hardesty asked for nominations from the floor for each position, three times;

- for **Secretary**, Brenda Hendricks with no additional nominations from the floor. Bob Zimmerman made a motion to close nominations for Secretary. Shirley Sprau 2nd. Motion carried.
- for **Treasurer**, Bob Zimmerman with no additional nominations from the floor. Jeff Warsaw made a motion to close nominations for Treasurer. 2nd by Aaron Warsaw. Motion carried.
- for **Elder**, Bill Schroeder, Don Warsaw and Jim Van Wakeman with no additional nominations from the floor. Annette Warsaw made a motion to close nominations for Elder. 2nd by Jeff Warsaw. Motion carried.
- for Assistant Sunday School Superintendent, Beth Bidner with no additional nominations from the floor. Shawn Zimmerman made a motion to close nominations for Asst. SS Superintendent. 2nd by Bryan Warsaw. Motion carried.
- for **Assistant Financial Secretary**, Larry Lutz with no additional nominations from the floor. Butch Sprau made a motion to close nominations. 2nd by John Gercken. Motion carried.
- for **Trustee**, John Gercken with no additional nominations from the floor. Bob Zimmerman made a motion to close nominations. 2nd by Brenda Hendricks. Motion carried.
- for **Head Usher**, Courtney Delaney and Gina Masko with no additional nominations from the floor. Roy Whitehouse made a motion to close

nominations. 2nd by Debbie Lammle. Motion carried.

Ballots were handed out to all voting members and counted. There was a tie for Elder, with a 2nd vote taken. Additional ballots were distributed with members voting once again and ballots counted. While the 2nd ballots were being counted we continued on with the meeting.

Pastor's Report

- Pastor thanked everyone for the generous gifts at Christmas for he and his family. He was overwhelmed at the generosity from congregation.
- He thanked everyone who had helped take time to visit the shut-in's and the ill over the past year.
- He thanked the past officers on the council who had served the congregation well over the past year and anyone who had stepped up to volunteer their time for the church with the new council.
- The Christmas program on Christmas Eve was well attended and he thanked Annette Warsaw with her talents, the choir, the teachers and children of the congregation, along with everyone who helped also to fill treat bags for the guests.
- Confirmation classes are going well, thanks to Debbie Lammle for her teaching assistance with the class. April 21st will be questioning Confirmation will be on April 28th.
- The church records have all been recorded online now. Proofing will be taking place soon and hopefully by the end of the 2nd quarter we can get a listing of all family members dates back to you to confirm and to add any updates.

Old Business

- Chairman Hardesty stated the door project in the hall has been completed since the last voters meeting. Dave Hasty has been asked to put a closer on the new door, due to wind issues. That will be done very soon.
- Chairman Hardesty gave an update on the AED training that will be held with the Gibson Hospital on the AED that the church purchased. Jill Hardesty is working with the hospital contact on the date that will be relayed when a date and time has been
- Handicapped parking spaces will be addressed in the spring.

New Business

- The vicar situation was then asked about and explained more by Pastor McPike. Thoughts were asked if we could get a summer vicar again. Pastor McPike will be checking on it in the next month or so and yes, we were very interested in the program again.
- Chairman Hardesty thanked the Committee and their husbands for their talents shown to the council over the past year.
- Chairman Hardesty then announced the results of the 2013 Church council vote:

- The quarterly report was gone over for presentation to the congregation for the Voters meeting on Sunday, 1/13.
- Barb and John Gercken has audited the Treasury books and found them to be in order.
- Treasurer Mike Hendricks stated that he paid \$.10 too much in tax to the state of Illinois. That credit will be rolled over for 2013 taxes next year.

Pastor's Report




