<u>Church Council Minutes</u> July 2, 2013

7 members, plus Pastor McPike and Vicar Scheck attended the monthly council meeting held on July 2 in the fellowship hall.

Secretary's minutes were read and approved. Treasurer, Bob Zimmerman, reported a balance of \$92,043.70. Mercy ships will be the recipient of our July mission giving.

Pastor McPike was very gracious for the reception honoring his 25 years in the ministry. He announced that Vicar Scheck will be teaching a Bible Class on Wednesday nights at 7 PM through August. The lessons will be based on the following Sunday's gospel lesson.

The council congratulated Nikki Gallier on an excellent Vacation Bible School program.

The trustees met with Strum Electric about the malfunctioning lights in the annex. It is not a grounding problem, but new electronic ballasts need to be installed in the fixtures along with cool white lights. The trustees will do this work.

Chairman Hardesty collected some quotes for tuck pointing of the church. The quotes were around \$16,000. Gutters need to be installed so that the water does not drain down the face of the bricks.

The property insurance policy from Country Companies will increase by \$369 a year. This insures all the buildings on the church property for a value of \$817,800.

Chairman Hardesty gathered some quotes to trim up the trees in front of the church, remove the dead cedar tree by the railroad, and cut the dead out of the top of the ash tree by the marquee. Don Warsaw offered to do the job.

The council approved the purchase of two

Fisher Fair passes for Deb and Dick Johnson for a small token for all of the work that he does for our church.

The July quarterly voters' meeting was called to order by Chairman Rick Hardesty with Pastor leading the voters in opening devotion based on the hymn "Hark the Voice of Jesus Crying". 34 members were present and no one new signed the constitution.

The secretary's minutes were read and approved. Bob Zimmerman gave the treasurer's report with a balance of \$92,043.70. Bob explained several accounts and after some discussion, the report was approved.

Pastor McPike thanked all who helped with Vacation Bible School. He thanked all who planned and attended his 25th anniversary in the ministry celebration. Vicar Scheck will be teaching a weekly Wednesday Bible Class on the gospel for the next Sunday. Since the picnic has been rescheduled for August 18th, Communion will be served the first and second Sundays in August. Pastor explained the new way of electing the synodical president. President Harrison was re-elected. He explained the various area churches and districts that we pray for each Sunday and are listed in the bulletin and in return other churches are praying for Osman.

Old business consisted of explaining the update on the church property insurance. The premiums did go up \$369 a year, but now all buildings and their contents are covered.

New business was lead by John Gercken who offered a small report on the need for tuck pointing on the church and annex. Since the church does not have gutters, the water is running down the bricks and some damage needs to be repaired. Chairman Hardesty got two quotes from companies in Mahomet. Both were around \$16,000. This does not include gutters. A motion was made to do the project with the trustees and council bringing the exact quotes back to the congregation. New curtains under the balcony were discussed. The tree trimming job on the grounds of the church was taken on by Don Warsaw. The lights in the annex will be fixed with electronic ballasts and cool white lights and will be done by the trustees. The youth trip presentation will be given after church next Sunday. A thank you was read to all the members who helped with the July 4th Bellflower parade float.

The meeting was adjourned with the Lord's Prayer.
