6 members, plus Pastor McPike and Vicar Scheck attended the monthly council meeting held on August 6 in the fellowship hall.

Secretary's minutes were read and approved. Treasurer, Bob Zimmerman, reported a balance of \$96,355.26. Report was approved. Christ Lutheran High School in Buckley will be the recipient of our August mission giving.

Pastor lead his report off with the discussion of Pastor Dan Fienen's call to Michigan and the vicar's departure. If Pastor Fienen accepts his call, it leaves Osman with the need for someone to assist. Pastor McPike will express this need at the Circuit meeting and also will contact the CID office if see if there are any retired pastors in the area.


