### <u>Church Council Minutes</u> <u>June 3, 2014</u> (Abridged Edition)

6 members, plus Pastor McPike and Vicar Cockran, attended the monthly council meeting held on June 3rd in the fellowship hall.

Secretary's minutes were read and approved. Treasurer Bob Zimmerman reported the cash balance being 63,860.46 at the end of May. The monthly mission giving project for June was previously approved for Concordia University in River Forest for scholarships.

Pastor introduced our summer vicar, Kurt Cockran, to the council. He moved in last week to his apartment in Fisher. He will be starting a Bible study class on Wednesday nights starting next week. Pastor asked to switch Communion from the third Sunday to the second Sunday in July due to a preaching schedule switch. This will work well so the VBS Sunday will not be a Communion Sunday.

Pastor McPike then elaborated on the internet installation at the church. John Gercken had done some communicating with the Wireless Data Net service and had emailed the council members earlier of the information. Pastor felt that the 4 megabytes per second for \$44.95 per month was reasonable. There is a \$100 equipment lease with free installation. It would be installed in the west side of the fellowship hall. We would then trench it to the church where the wires are already fed to the furnace room. There was much trepidation on trenching safely with other underground utilities and pipes. Chairman Hardesty will get a map designed of the underground systems between the church and hall before any trenching is done. It was agreed to start a trial period with these terms.

The elders were asked to program the air conditioner to turn on earlier for the Sunday morning service since summer has started. They also were asked to be the acolytes when there are no other acolytes present.

Bob Zimmerman gave the trustees report. He reported that Chief Bauer does not want to bother the present duct work to get more air returns installed for the air conditioner/furnace. They will install two new vents going up to the balcony. They will send an estimate for this work.

Chairman Hardesty then proceeded to the new business. He reported that the annex window would be cut and boarded up this week. Dick Johnson and Donnie Warsaw would do that. Most of the front of the church except the bell tower has been ground out so progress is being made around the church.

Bob Zimmerman notified us that the church has received the new tax exempt letter. Anyone who is going to purchase something for the church needs to get a copy of this letter. Brenda Hendricks presented the idea of purchasing a set of ceramic bells for the Sunday School children to play during VBS and some special worship services. The council approved to purchase them out of the Norma Homann memorial account for approximately \$70.

The social committee submitted the following dates to the council: Vicar Farewell potluck – July 27<sup>th</sup>, church picnic – August 10, wiener roast/hayride – September 28<sup>th</sup>, and pastor appreciation – October 12.

The meeting was adjourned with the Lord's Prayer.

Chairman Hardesty explained to the voter assembly that there needs to be some additional duct work done to the present air conditioner/furnace and the expense is more than the council has authority to spend. The installer of our new system, Chief/Bauer, has given us a quote of \$650 for supplies and labor to install the duct work to add additional air returns and make the system quieter. It should make the choir loft cooler and could help with our propane usage. Butch Sprau made the motion to accept this quote. Darwin Warsaw seconded. Motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned.
