<u>Church Council Minutes</u> <u>September 2, 2014</u> (Abridged Edition)

6 members, plus Pastor McPike, attended the monthly council meeting held on September 2, in the fellowship hall.

Secretary's minutes were read and approved. Treasurer Bob Zimmerman reported the cash balance as \$70,727.14 as of the end of August. Jeff Warsaw made the motion to give our monthly mission money to the National Olympic Organization for September, The Mahomet School District food program for October, the Blue Ridge School District back pack program for November, and the Fisher food pantry for December. Neil seconded and the motion passed.

Pastor McPike requested that the signup sheet for the council officers that are needed for 2015 be posted on the back bulletin board in October. He announced that Christian Education Sunday would be celebrated the Sunday after Labor Day weekend. He outlined the schedule for the confirmands with class beginning on September 14. He also announced that Osman would be hosting the circuit pastor's conference on the following Tuesday with the worship service beginning at 9 AM. The social committee would be serving coffee and breakfast food and also lunch.

Beth has ordered and received the <u>ABCs of Faith</u> book for the Sunday School children for promotion Sunday. She has also received the Christmas program material.

Jeff Warsaw reported that there were about 25 bricks left from the tuck pointing project. As soon as the rain cleans them off, they will be stored in the storage shed. John Gercken worked on the receptacle in the annex and installed it above the counter top so that it is easier to plug in the copier and folding

machine. Jeff is going to contact Chief Bauer about how loud the intake vent in the back of the church is. If they cannot correct the problem, the council gave approval to seek a second opinion. Discussion followed about not being able to hear the service in the back of the church. Under the balcony there is only one speaker in the center so the council approved the purchase of 3 speakers which is one for each section under the balcony.

In old business, Chairman Hardesty thanked Jeff and Donnie Warsaw, Bob Zimmerman, and Pastor McPike for their work on installing the internet. He also thanked Nick Haggin for donating materials for the project. The tuck pointing project was completed to our satisfaction and the new window has been installed in the annex. Now Dick Johnson and Donnie Warsaw will work on the fascia boards and then the guttering will follow to complete the project.

The meeting was adjourned with the Lord's Prayer.


