Immanuel Lutheran Church Council Minutes October 7, 2015

The Osman Lutheran Church Council held it monthly meeting on October 7, 2015 in the Fellowship Hall with eight members present. Those attending were Lee Whitehouse, Steve Martin, Susie Martin, Diana Zimmerman, Bob Zimmerman, Debbie Lammle, Rick Hardesty, and Pastor McPike. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Hardesty, followed by devotion by Pastor McPike. The Secretary's minutes were read by Debbie Lammle. Lee Whitehouse made a motion to accept the minutes, Bob Zimmerman seconded; motion carried. Bob Zimmerman read the Treasurer's report with a balance of \$84,560.59. Steve Martin made the motion to accept the report, Debbie Lammle seconded, motion carried. The monthly Mission giving project was given to the Fisher Food Pantry.

Pastor's Report

Pastor McPike announced that David and Sara Kunde transferred to Immanuel Osman from Faith Lutheran, Monticello. Pastor Deen is filling in at Immanuel Loda, during Pastor Allen's illness. Brenda Hendricks was thanked for filling in during Linda Warsaw's absence. It was then discussed buying Microsoft Publisher for the church. A text message will be sent on the first Tuesday of every month at 10am to everyone who signed up for notices on their cell phone. Pastor McPike will be gone on the second Sunday in November.

Old Business

Discussion was held on the following topics: Ceiling fans, updating wiring, condition of bell tower, cleaning mold at the top of the church, seal on the refrigerator, new leaf blower with an approximate cost of \$150, constant air movement decreasing the running of the furnace/air conditioner, temperature sensors on new

fans, maintenance agreements on furnaces and air conditioners in both buildings, furnace filters changed quarterly, disposing of old windows, another bid on new speakers, and hanging of fire extinguishers.

Three new windows, that had been approved at a past voter's meeting, were purchased and put in the annex and Pastor's office. Chairman Hardesty thanked Dick Johnson, Steve Martin, and John Lammle for completing this project.

New Business

A sign-up for new officers for 2016-17 will be placed on the bulletin board in the church. The positions open for next year include Chairman, two elders, one trustee, Assistant Finance, Assistant Sunday School Superintendent, and Head Usher. Men and women can hold most positions, except elder.

Chairman Hardesty told the council members to be thinking about the budget, which needs to be in place by the December newsletter. It was discussed to budget for the ramp on the south east corner of the church.

Chairman Hardesty then stated that members may bring their favorite German beverage to the Reformation Fest and Pastor Appreciation Event on October 25th. He will explain this to the congregation at the Voter's Meeting.

Lee Whitehouse offered to plow snow around the church this winter, with Steve Martin on stand-by. Lee Whitehouse will make adjustments on the mowing schedule, as some members have asked to be removed from the list. Trustees will make the decision if services will be called off due to inclement weather.

The council agreed that Brenda Hendricks should get the bulletins for LWML Sunday copied from an outside source, because of a problem with the church copier.

Discussion was then held on the video camera in the church. It was decided that viewing the video pictures would be password protected. The council approved an

outside video camera on the southwest corner of the church.

Pastor McPike stated that the Sadorus Lutheran Church pastor invited our youth to accompany them to the National Youth Gathering next year. The council was also informed that Annie Downey (sister of Nikki Gallier and Christie Delaney) was willing to be Youth Leader for the Immanuel Osman Youth at next year's event.

The News Gazette needs details for our Christmas service by December 11th. The Thanksgiving Meal and Service will again be held the Sunday before Thanksgiving at Immanuel Osman. Chairman Hardesty asked Debbie Lammle, Shirley Sprau, and Diana Zimmerman to plan the event.

The meeting ended with the Lord's Prayer.
