## **Holy Week in Jesus Day and Now**

<u>Holy Week</u> is the last week of the 40 day season of Lent and the week preceding Easter. In Holy Week we focus on the last week of Christ's life here on earth, remembering especially His Passion and Resurrection. <u>Palm Sunday</u> reminds us of the triumphal entry of

Jesus into Jerusalem at the beginning of Holy Week-a high point of joy for Jesus and His followers. Jesus was fulfilling His Father's will, and His followers were welcoming Him to the Holy City. This day takes its name from the fact that as Jesus approached Jerusalem on a donkey, the huge crowd that followed carried palm branches as they praised Him as the long awaited Messiah! Here at Osman, we share the palm branches made into crosses by the Altar Guild. On Maundy **Thursday**, Jesus' disciples wondered at the institution of the Lord's Supper and His new commandment to love as He washed His disciple's feet. At the end of our Maundy Thursday service, the altar is stripped in preparation for Good Friday. This symbolizes Christ being stripped by the Roman soldiers prior to His crucifixion. Holy Communion will be celebrated with homemade bread and wine. Good Friday was a busy and sorrowful day. Judas came with the chief priests and soldiers to betray and arrest Jesus. He was tried and sentenced to death. Jesus was nailed to the cross at the "third hour" (about 9am) and died at about the ninth hour (3pm). His body was removed from the cross and rushed to burial in a nearby tomb before sundown and the beginning of the Passover Sabbath. Easter Sunday - when the women visited the tomb early on the third day, they were alarmed by the presence of the angel and the empty tomb which initially caused great fear, but then fear and sadness turned to joy. With the angelic proclamation "He is Risen", we rejoice along with Jesus' followers, for His crucifixion redeemed us from sin and His resurrection guarantees our own! "Hallelujah, He has Risen Indeed!" Our Easter celebration includes Holy Communion with homemade bread and wine. Easter breakfast will be served by the youth following the service.

## **Church Council**

# <u>Immanuel Lutheran Council Minutes</u> <u>January 6, 2016</u>

The Immanuel Lutheran Church of Osman held their monthly Council meeting on January 6, 2016 with ten members present. Those attending were Rick Hardesty, Debbie Lammle, Bob Zimmerman, Susan Martin, Steve Martin, Diana Zimmerman, Lee Whitehouse, Jeff Warsaw, Connie Warsaw, and Pastor McPike. Pastor McPike opened the meeting with reading from Ephesians 3:1-12, followed by prayer. Secretary, Debbie Lammle, read the minutes from the last meeting. Diana Zimmerman made a motion to approve, Connie Warsaw seconded, motion carried. Bob Zimmerman gave the treasurer's report with a balance of \$83, 917.62. Steve Martin made a motion to approve, Lee Whitehouse seconded; motion carried. Treasurer Zimmerman thanked Chairman Hardesty who helped him set up a book-keeping spread sheet to make his job easier. He also informed the council that less kWh were used in 2015 than in 2014. Steve and Barb Gaines audited the Treasurer's books and gave their approval that all was correct.

Susan Martin made a motion to give our monthly giving to Salvation Army Men's Shelter in Champaign; Jeff Warsaw seconded; motion carried.

## Pastor's Report:

Pastor McPike thanked everyone for the gifts, cards, goodies, and all the expressions of appreciation he received at Christmas. Upcoming details: Pastor Ehler will fill in during the months of March and April when needed. Confirmation will be April 24<sup>th</sup>, with questioning on Feb. 24, March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, and 16<sup>th</sup> (last four mid-week Lenten services).

## Sunday School Superintendent Report:

Discussion began with compliments on the Children's Christmas Program by Chairman Hardesty and Pastor McPike. Connie Warsaw reported for Annette Warsaw in her absence. Connie mentioned she would use CPH materials for VBS, called "Barnyard Round-Up", and will order through the Christian Book Store.

#### **Trustees Report:**

Lee Whitehouse received bids for the materials needed of the wheelchair ramp project. The lumber expense for the complete deck is \$1196.78; the Polly decking cost (without wood structure) is \$2245.79. \$2500-\$3000 was the cost estimate for the door with an electric opener. (Quotes were obtained during an 11% discount sale on materials) Discussion then followed concerning the wheelchair ramp project, including adjoining sidewalks. Chairman Hardesty

stated that this project should be ADA compliant. It was suggested to table the topic, but give an overview at the Voter's Meeting the following Sunday. Champaign Mobility was suggested as a possible contact for a bid for the ramp. Lee Whitehouse will get the facts concerning compliancy and inform Chairman Hardesty of his findings. He also mentioned talking to Austin Miller, a member at Osman, to acquire his feelings about the project.

Bob Zimmerman made a motion to purchase a replacement flush value for the urinal in the men's restroom in the church from JC's at the cost of \$250. Steve Martin seconded; motion carried. Jeff Warsaw will take care of this purchase.

Completed trustee issues discussed: measured for blinds for the four windows in the annex and Pastor's office at a cost of \$234 by Lee Whitehouse, replaced the outside light in the marquee at the front of the church by Lee Whitehouse; board replaced in the furnace in the annex; new faucet for Women's restroom purchased by Steve Martin, test concerning mold on the ceiling of the church reported not to be a health hazard, and measurement taken for a rubber roof on the bell tower by McCumsey Construction.

Other trustee issues discussed: Needed repair from leak above the women's restroom in the attic, replaced batteries and pads for the defibulator in the annex by Shane Zimmerman and Rick Hardesty, better lightening on sides of steps in front and east of hall, motion lightening on the front and east of the hall, slick steps on east entrance to hall, and inside light of marquee changed.

### **New Business:**

Eternal flame candles were then discussed. The replacement candles last nine days, so they will be used for two Sunday services before changing. The elders will be notified. Pastor McPike informed the council that if the temperatures drop below 38 degrees in the hall, he will receive a warning on his cell phone. He also suggested leaving the cabinet doors open in the hall.

Discussion was then had on moving two long pews from under the balcony, replacing the pew with a fabric flaw in the front of the church, and taking the two long pews upstairs. The four smaller pews from the balcony would be placed downstairs. This topic was tabled till the next meeting.

It was suggested that a mail tray be placed in the annex for written requests for work done by the trustees.

The council was informed that the youth will sponsor the Valentine's Dinner on February 13<sup>th</sup> in the Fellowship Hall beginning at 5pm. Trustees were asked to approve this event.

The proposed slate of officers were read for the upcoming election. It was suggested that we have one or two more trustees elected each year. Pastor McPike stated that the by-laws would have to be changed and the suggested change be posted a month in advance of a vote. It was reminded that trustees are the organizers and can delegate the work.

Debbie Lammle and Diana Zimmerman volunteered to prepare the drinks for the Voter's Potluck on January 10<sup>th</sup>. Outgoing officers will count the ballots after the election. Installation will be held at the end of the Voter's Meeting.

Meeting ended with the Lord's Prayer.
