LWML Meeting

President Debbie Lammle opened the quarterly LWML meeting on March 8, 2018 with eleven members present. After singing the new LWML song and reciting the pledge, Barb W. Gercken gave devotion, followed by Barb Gaines with topic. Wilma Grussing took roll and read the minutes in Shirley Sprau's absence. Sue VanWakeman gave the Treasurer's report with a balance of \$706.29. Mites were collected, followed by correspondence from our seminary student, Chris Walters, Pastor Henry's son-in-law. Thank yous were also read from Pastor McPike and Sharon, Pastor and Mrs. Ehlers, and our adopted family, Tina Braaten and family. Cards were sent to Sara Kunde, Jim Poppe, Esther Lutz, Lee Bidner, Jodi Burgess, Jeri Bidner, Don Warsaw, the shut-ins, Mr. & Mrs. Chris Duncan and family, and Mr. & Mrs. Kenny Nelson. Thanks were given to the committees taking food to Esther & Larry Lutz and Sara and Dave Kunde; thanks were also given to those making quilt tops and pillowcase dresses. Additional thanks were given to Debbie Martin and all those who gave gifts, gift cards, or money to our adopted family and to all LWML women who brought refreshments to the Ash Wednesday social hour.

Old Business: 59 quilts and 59 pillowcase dresses have been made so far since the beginning of the year. Upcoming dates for quilting include April 3 and 5, May 1 and 3, and June 5 and 7. CID-LWML paid their first four mission grants for a total of \$51,850. The grant for Student Aid for Church Workers, Ft. Wayne & St. Louis Seminary Food Banks, Human Trafficking Education, and Immanuel Lutheran Church, Charleston Comfort Dog Ministry were all funded in full. The next Clarion Deadline is April 25th and the Danville Zone is urged to add articles.

The owner of the Mahomet Quilting Bee is machine quilting the quilt made by past and present LWML members of Osman. It was suggested that our LWML begin a new tradition and give one of our quilts to our benefit recipient and to our adopted family. A new adopted family was suggested but not contacted yet. The chairman for our Military Biblestick project is Barb Gaines. She suggested showing a CD describing this project between Sunday School and Church on an upcoming Sunday. The Baby Bottle project for Crisis Nursery will be postponed till January.

Debbie Lammle and Marlene Schultz, Zone LWML President, presented the principal of Danville Lutheran School with a check for \$945.81, funds collected for last year's zone project. The same amount was also given to Christ Lutheran HS, Buckley, St. John's Lutheran Church, Buckley, and St. Paul's Lutheran School of Woodworth.

New Business: An invitation was read for the LWML Spring Gathering to be held at Immanuel Loda on April 7th, beginning with registration at 8:15. After all churches respond on the number attending, President Lammle will contact those who need to make breads for this event. Another invitation was read for the CID-LWML Convention on April 27-28th in Bloomington. Connie Warsaw and Barb Gaines will be the delegates for this event. Copies of Mission Grant Proposals were passed out, and will need to be returned to Debbie Lammle by April 22nd after selecting

four of the 21 grants.
