# Immanuel Lutheran Church of Osman Annual Voters Meeting – February 10, 2019

Chairman Hardesty called the meeting to order at 10:40 with all in attendance signing in. Pastor McPike lead the congregation in prayer. Chairman Hardesty read the minutes of the October 2018 Quarterly Voters meeting in the absence of Secretary Sandy Whitehouse's absence. A motion was made by Darwin Warsaw to approve the minutes as read; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Butch Sprau. Motion carried.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> - Treasurer John Lammle provided the year-end Treasurer's report. The checking account balance as of 12/31/2018 is \$65,449.54. A question was made from Annette Warsaw regarding the Vacation Bible School budgeting. John will double check with the Accountant on her question and respond as soon as he has an answer for her. In a Memorial report, John listed

the Mike Hendricks memorial has been exhausted. In the Stewardship report, all money has been used for 2018. \$2,523 will be available for the 2019. A motion was made by Darwin Warsaw to approve the Treasurer's report; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jeff Warsaw. Motion carried. Pastor's Report — Pastor McPike thanked all who hold roles in the church as we are all very essential to this church.

- Pastor Ehlers is going to be preaching the Lenten mid-week services this Easter season and Pastor McPike will be bringing him in the evenings.
- Pastor also noted that his mother is continuing declining in health and might be gone several times soon.
- Catechism class continues to go well
- Membership changes requested to be transferred out of Osman: The Schuhs, Mahomet to Trinity in Urbana, IL and Gaines's moved to Long Beach, Mississippi and also asked for a transfer out.

<u>Old Business</u> - Chairman Hardesty asked for Old Business.

• Sue VanWakeman thanked Don Warsaw for fixing the light on the pulpit.

New Business – Chairman Hardesty called for Treasurer Lammle to discuss the proposed 2019 budget. The 2018 overall income was down. The council based the 2019 budget with income set from the 2018 actuals. He is presenting the total budget of \$115,757.

- Wage increases included 1% for the Pastors and paid staff also.
- The VBS budget for 2018 was \$650. \$712 was spent and the 2019 Budget that is proposed is \$700. A question was asked from Theresa VanWakeman Wilson regarding service on the organ. Discussion was held and determined the service was completed 2 years ago.
- Mission giving included \$450 for the Stewardship committee.
- Darwin Warsaw asked a question on the Joint Seminary Fund was one fund better than the other one? Pastor McPike explained that is was support to seminary students overall, not specific families like the LWML sponsors. His question was answered.

A motion was made by Larry Lutz to approve the 2019 budget. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dave Kunde. Motion carried.

Chairman Hardesty then called for nominations from the floor for new council members.

Secretary – Jill Hardesty Elder - Bob Zimmerman Dwight Hooker Trustee – Lee Whitehouse Asst. Finance – Susan Martin Sunday School Superintendent – Beth Bidner

A motion was made by Darwin Warsaw that the nomination list be closed and the Secretary position be closed. 2<sup>nd</sup> Butch Sprau. Motion carried.

- Chairman Hardesty asked for any other New Business. Darwin Warsaw gave an update on Kade Nichols, a former benefit recipient. He will now be going to Chicago for additional rehab.
- Annette Warsaw announced she will be taking over the Youth Group after the Valentines dinner on Feb. 16<sup>th</sup>, 2019.
- Chairman Hardesty thanked all former council members for their service to the congregation.
- Don Warsaw also thanked Pastor McPike for the sermon today due to the short notice of Pastor Ehlers not being able to give the sermon. Pastor McPike's sermon was totally off-the-cuff with no prepared sermon before he came to church and he rocked it!
- Chairman Hardesty called for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Barb Whitehouse-Gercken made that motion. The meeting was adjourned with the Lord's Prayer.
