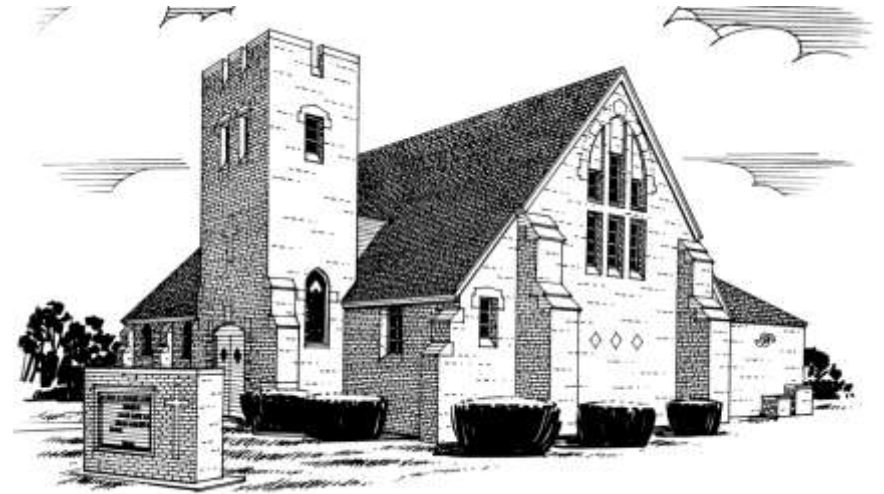

Welcome to John Britton from Buckley, Illinois, who is leading our adult Bible class and hymn sing today in the absence of Pastor McPike.

Pastor McPike is preaching today at the home church of his mother’s side of the family, Calvary Lutheran Church, Bedford, Indiana. Pastor attended there when visiting grandparents as a boy. Pastor’s mother began playing the organ at Calvary at age 12 (and continued off and on for the next 60 years at various churches). She was confirmed there, she and pastor’s dad were married there, and his dad was catechized into the Lutheran faith there. Pastor’s two-day-old older brother was buried by Calvary’s pastor in 1959.

Operation Christmas Child.....we will be packing shoe boxes for Operation Christmas Child in November for children in poor countries across the world. Since school supplies are on sale NOW, this would be a good time to purchase the items needed. We need 23 glue sticks, 7 scissors, 24 pencil sharpeners, 10 boxes of 24 crayons, 23 boxes of markers (10-12 packs), 17 boxes of 10-12 pack of colored pencils, 24 toothbrushes, 24 – 48 ink pens, 2 wash cloths, and 24 nail clippers. We usually pack 12 boxes for boys and 12 boxes for girls. If you would like to donate there is a collection box on a back pew. If you prefer to give a cash donation, we would be glad to buy items that are needed. Two Thrivent Action Team cards will be used to buy larger items and to pay the \$10 postage fee (maybe more) for each box.
